OVERVIEW OF CRAWFORDSVILLE HUMANE SOCIETY

THE CRAWFORDSVILLE HUMANE SOCIETY IS A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION DEDICATED TO THE RESCUE, SHELTER, AND REHOMING OF ANIMALS IN NEED WITHIN THE CRAWFORDSVILLE AREA. ESTABLISHED WITH THE MISSION TO PREVENT CRUELTY AND PROMOTE KINDNESS TOWARD ALL ANIMALS, IT SERVES AS A VITAL RESOURCE FOR ANIMAL WELFARE IN THE COMMUNITY. THE ORGANIZATION OPERATES A SHELTER FACILITY THAT PROVIDES TEMPORARY CARE FOR LOST, ABANDONED, OR SURRENDERED PETS UNTIL THEY CAN BE ADOPTED INTO PERMANENT HOMES. THROUGH FUNDRAISING EVENTS, PUBLIC OUTREACH, AND PARTNERSHIPS WITH LOCAL AUTHORITIES, THE HUMANE SOCIETY ENHANCES ITS CAPACITY TO ASSIST ANIMALS AND EDUCATE THE PUBLIC ON RESPONSIBLE PET OWNERSHIP.

MISSION AND VISION

THE CORE MISSION OF THE CRAWFORDSVILLE IN HUMANE SOCIETY IS TO PROTECT ANIMALS FROM NEGLECT AND ABUSE WHILE FOSTERING A COMMUNITY THAT VALUES AND RESPECTS ANIMAL LIFE. THE ORGANIZATION ENVISIONS A FUTURE WHERE EVERY ANIMAL HAS A LOVING HOME AND ADEQUATE CARE, SUPPORTED BY COMMUNITY AWARENESS AND ACTIVE PARTICIPATION IN ANIMAL WELFARE INITIATIVES.

SERVICES OFFERED

THE HUMANE SOCIETY PROVIDES A RANGE OF SERVICES INCLUDING ANIMAL RESCUE, SHELTERING, ADOPTION, SPAY/NEUTER PROGRAMS, AND EDUCATION. THESE SERVICES ARE DESIGNED TO REDUCE PET OVERPOPULATION, PROMOTE PUBLIC SAFETY, AND IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR ANIMALS IN THE AREA.

ADOPTION SERVICES AND PROCESS

ADOPTION IS A PRIMARY FUNCTION OF THE CRAWFORDSVILLE HUMANE SOCIETY, OFFERING COMMUNITY MEMBERS THE

OPPORTUNITY TO GIVE HOMELESS ANIMALS A SECOND CHANCE. THE FACILITY HOUSES DOGS, CATS, AND OTHER SMALL ANIMALS AVAILABLE FOR ADOPTION. EACH ANIMAL UNDERGOES THOROUGH HEALTH AND BEHAVIORAL ASSESSMENTS BEFORE BEING PLACED FOR ADOPTION TO ENSURE THE BEST MATCH FOR FAMILIES AND INDIVIDUALS.

ADOPTION PROCEDURES

THE ADOPTION PROCESS INVOLVES AN APPLICATION, AN INTERVIEW, AND SOMETIMES A HOME VISIT TO ENSURE THAT THE PROSPECTIVE ADOPTER IS PREPARED TO PROVIDE A SAFE AND LOVING ENVIRONMENT. THE HUMANE SOCIETY STAFF GUIDES ADOPTERS THROUGH SELECTING A PET THAT FITS THEIR LIFESTYLE AND PROVIDES POST-ADOPTION SUPPORT TO FACILITATE A SMOOTH TRANSITION.

ADOPTION FEES AND REQUIREMENTS

ADOPTION FEES HELP COVER THE COSTS OF VETERINARY CARE, VACCINATIONS, SPAYING/NEUTERING, AND SHELTER MAINTENANCE. REQUIREMENTS OFTEN INCLUDE PROOF OF RESIDENCE, IDENTIFICATION, AND AGREEMENT TO RESPONSIBLE PET CARE PRACTICES. THE HUMANE SOCIETY EMPHASIZES THE IMPORTANCE OF COMMITMENT TO LONG-TERM PET OWNERSHIP.

VOLUNTEER AND COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

VOLUNTEERS ARE ESSENTIAL TO THE DAILY OPERATIONS AND SUCCESS OF THE CRAWFORDSVILLE HUMANE SOCIETY. THE ORGANIZATION OFFERS VARIOUS VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES THAT ALLOW COMMUNITY MEMBERS TO CONTRIBUTE THEIR TIME AND SKILLS TOWARD ANIMAL CARE, FUNDRAISING, AND EDUCATIONAL OUTREACH.

- ANIMAL CARE ASSISTANTS – FEEDING, GROOMING, AND EXERCISING SHELTER ANIMALS
- ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT – ASSISTING WITH OFFICE TASKS AND RECORD-KEEPING
- EVENT VOLUNTEERS – HELPING ORGANIZE AND STAFF FUNDRAISING AND ADOPTION EVENTS
- OUTREACH COORDINATORS – PROMOTING HUMANE SOCIETY PROGRAMS WITHIN THE COMMUNITY

BENEFITS OF VOLUNTEERING

VOLUNTEERS GAIN VALUABLE EXPERIENCE IN ANIMAL WELFARE, BUILD CONNECTIONS WITH OTHER ANIMAL LOVERS, AND PLAY A DIRECT ROLE IN IMPROVING THE LIVES OF ANIMALS. THE HUMANE SOCIETY PROVIDES TRAINING AND SUPPORT TO ENSURE VOLUNTEERS ARE EFFECTIVE AND ENGAGED IN THEIR ROLES.

PROGRAMS AND EDUCATIONAL OUTREACH

EDUCATION IS A KEY COMPONENT OF THE CRAWFORDSVILLE HUMANE SOCIETY'S EFFORTS TO FOSTER A COMPASSIONATE COMMUNITY. THE ORGANIZATION OFFERS PROGRAMS DESIGNED TO TEACH RESPONSIBLE PET OWNERSHIP, ANIMAL SAFETY, AND THE IMPORTANCE OF SPAYING AND NEUTERING PETS TO CONTROL OVERPOPULATION.

COMMUNITY EDUCATION INITIATIVES

THROUGH SCHOOL VISITS, WORKSHOPS, AND PUBLIC SEMINARS, THE HUMANE SOCIETY RAISES AWARENESS ABOUT ANIMAL WELFARE ISSUES AND ENCOURAGES HUMANE TREATMENT OF ANIMALS. THESE INITIATIVES AIM TO REDUCE NEGLECT AND ABUSE BY INFORMING RESIDENTS ABOUT PROPER PET CARE AND THE BENEFITS OF ADOPTION.

SPAY AND NEUTER PROGRAMS

ONE OF THE MOST IMPACTFUL SERVICES OFFERED IS THE LOW-COST SPAY AND NEUTER PROGRAM, WHICH HELPS CONTROL THE LOCAL PET POPULATION AND REDUCES THE NUMBER OF ANIMALS ENTERING THE SHELTER SYSTEM. THIS PROGRAM IS OFTEN SUBSIDIZED OR OFFERED IN PARTNERSHIP WITH VETERINARY CLINICS TO MAXIMIZE ACCESSIBILITY FOR PET OWNERS.

ANIMAL CARE AND SHELTER FACILITIES

THE CRAWFORDSVILLE HUMANE SOCIETY OPERATES A WELL-MAINTAINED SHELTER DESIGNED TO PROVIDE A SAFE, CLEAN, AND COMFORTABLE ENVIRONMENT FOR ANIMALS AWAITING ADOPTION. THE FACILITY INCLUDES QUARANTINE AREAS, MEDICAL TREATMENT ROOMS, AND PLAY SPACES TO ENSURE THE PHYSICAL AND EMOTIONAL WELL-BEING OF EACH ANIMAL.

HEALTH AND MEDICAL CARE

ANIMALS IN THE SHELTER RECEIVE COMPREHENSIVE VETERINARY CARE, INCLUDING VACCINATIONS, PARASITE CONTROL, AND TREATMENT FOR INJURIES OR ILLNESSES. THE HUMANE SOCIETY COLLABORATES WITH LOCAL VETERINARIANS TO MAINTAIN HIGH STANDARDS OF ANIMAL HEALTH AND WELFARE.

- INDOOR AND OUTDOOR KENNELS TAILORED TO SPECIES AND SIZE
- ISOLATION AREAS FOR SICK OR NEWLY ARRIVED ANIMALS
- SANITATION PROTOCOLS TO PREVENT DISEASE TRANSMISSION
- COMFORT AMENITIES SUCH AS BEDDING, TOYS, AND SOCIALIZATION OPPORTUNITIES

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT SERVICES DOES THE CRAWFORDSVILLE HUMANE SOCIETY PROVIDE?

THE CRAWFORDSVILLE HUMANE SOCIETY PROVIDES ANIMAL SHELTERING, ADOPTION SERVICES, LOST AND FOUND PET ASSISTANCE, AND COMMUNITY EDUCATION ON ANIMAL CARE AND WELFARE.

HOW CAN I ADOPT A PET FROM THE CRAWFORDSVILLE HUMANE SOCIETY?

TO ADOPT A PET FROM THE CRAWFORDSVILLE HUMANE SOCIETY, VISIT THEIR SHELTER DURING OPEN HOURS, MEET THE AVAILABLE ANIMALS, AND COMPLETE AN ADOPTION APPLICATION. STAFF WILL GUIDE YOU THROUGH THE PROCESS AND HELP YOU FIND A SUITABLE PET.

WHAT ARE THE OPERATING HOURS OF THE CRAWFORDSVILLE HUMANE SOCIETY?

THE CRAWFORDSVILLE HUMANE SOCIETY TYPICALLY OPERATES FROM 10 AM TO 5 PM TUESDAY THROUGH SATURDAY, BUT IT'S BEST TO CHECK THEIR OFFICIAL WEBSITE OR CALL AHEAD FOR THE MOST CURRENT HOURS.

CAN I VOLUNTEER AT THE CRAWFORDSVILLE HUMANE SOCIETY?

YES, THE CRAWFORDSVILLE HUMANE SOCIETY WELCOMES VOLUNTEERS TO HELP WITH ANIMAL CARE, EVENTS, AND ADMINISTRATIVE TASKS. INTERESTED INDIVIDUALS CAN APPLY THROUGH THEIR WEBSITE OR CONTACT THE SHELTER DIRECTLY.

IF YOU FIND A LOST PET IN CRAWFORDSVILLE, YOU SHOULD CONTACT THE CRAWFORDSVILLE HUMANE SOCIETY TO REPORT THE ANIMAL AND SEE IF THE OWNER HAS BEEN LOCATED. YOU CAN ALSO POST ON LOCAL SOCIAL MEDIA GROUPS AND CHECK WITH NEARBY VETERINARIANS.
