Should we call an ambulance or can I drive you? he questioned. This was the start of a 7 month journey from near death to overcoming obstacles the medical profession did not believe I was capable of. Three months were spent with my body trying to heal in order to live the other four were spent in rehab. My next year and a half culminated in walking with a cane and driving very short distances.
