UNDERSTANDING TEACHER AND STUDENT SWAP DAY

SAFETY AND SUPPORT MEASURES

- PROVIDE COMPREHENSIVE TRAINING AND SUPPORT FOR STUDENT TEACHERS BEFORE THE SWAP DAY
- DESIGN FLEXIBLE LESSON PLANS THAT ACCOMMODATE THE SWAP DAY FORMAT
- ESTABLISH CLEAR RULES AND EXPECTATIONS FOR CLASSROOM CONDUCT
- ENCOURAGE TEACHERS TO REFLECT OPENLY ON THEIR EXPERIENCES TO NORMALIZE ROLE REVERSAL
- COORDINATE WITH ADMINISTRATORS TO ENSURE SMOOTH SCHEDULING AND RESOURCE ALLOCATION

IMPACT ON SCHOOL CULTURE AND LEARNING ENVIRONMENT
