Complete the circuit by connecting the hot wire from the second three way switch to the light fixture's hot terminal. Connect the neutral wire from the power source directly to the light fixture's neutral terminal.

Step 8: Ground All Components

Ensure that all switches, boxes, and fixtures are properly grounded by connecting the ground wires to the grounding terminals or grounding screws.

Step 9: Test the Circuit

After completing all connections, restore power at the breaker and test the switches to confirm the light operates correctly from all locations.
